Dumpster Day–Saturday-October 21st, 2023 - 8 am- 2 pm

The Village will accept the following items for the fees indicated at a dumpster located at the Village Maintenance Shop at 15866 West Judd St. (below Impact Gel).

Items can be dropped off between 8 a.m. & 2 p.m. Please do not leave refuse at the dumpster before or after the scheduled hours. **The dumpster and appliance and furniture disposal is for Village of Ettrick residents only.**

- ❖ Refrigerators, dehumidifiers, freezers, air conditioners, stoves, washers and dryers, water heaters, furnaces and computers - **\$15.00**
- ❖ Microwaves, small TV's & VCR's and computer monitors - **\$10.00**
- ❖ Large TV's (32 inch +) and sofa beds - **\$20.00**
- ❖ Couches, chairs, mattresses and other furniture- **\$10.00**
- ❖ Small chairs- **\$5.00**

❖ 8 foot (or shorter) fluorescent bulbs- **\$1.00**

Metal, tail pipes, mufflers, wire, window glass, concrete, wood under (4) feet in length and small amounts of building materials will be accepted at 6¢/pound or \$120.00/ton. Individual pricing will be determined by the attendant in charge. Paint is not accepted at the dumpster, but you may bring paint cans containing small amounts of dried paint. Used oil will be accepted in proper containers. Payment must be made before disposal and **checks should be made payable to Village of Ettrick**. Full truckloads must present a weight slip.

Ettrick's Utility Billing Software will be upgraded in 2024. The Village Office will be closed the week of November 20th to begin the system conversion



BUILDING-ZONING-DEMOLITION PERMITS

Before starting any building or remodeling projects, accessory buildings, windows, siding or roofing, contact Village Clerk Jane Jensen at 608-525-5445 for a building permit application.

The application must be submitted, along with drawings of the proposed project, to the Village Board for approval at their meeting on the 1st Tuesday of the month. Projects cannot begin before final approval and issuance of the permit. Before beginning demolition projects, it may be necessary to obtain a demolition permit from the D.N.R. A dumpster is necessary to dispose of materials for all building, remodeling, roofing and demolition projects. For any new construction you must contact the Trempealeau Co. Office of Land Management at 715-538-2311 ext. 223



DISPOSAL OF SOLID WASTE- Residential dumpsters are not allowed in the village.

Village of Ettrick garbage bags are available at the Village Office and Ettrick Express Mart for \$3.00/bag. **Tri-City Sanitation provides curbside garbage pick-up every Wednesday. Have your garbage at the curb by 7 a.m. Please have bags tied shut or they will not be picked up.** Commercial businesses must contract with Tri-City Sanitation for pick-up service and dumpster rental at 1-715-538-4311. **NO GARBAGE OR TRASH BURNING** is allowed in the Village. **If a holiday falls on Wednesday, garbage will be picked up on the following day.**



RECYCLING

Attached is a recycling pick up calendar and an information sheet on recyclable items and directions for preparing them. **Curbside pick-up of recyclables is provided by**

Hilltopper Refuse every other Thursday. One recycling bin is provided at no charge to each household and must be left at the residence. If you move and take the bin, you will be charged \$25.00 for a replacement bin. Extra recycling should be in a laundry basket alongside your recycling bin. If a **recycling bin** is not at the curb or your recyclables are not properly prepared your recycling will not be picked up. If you have any questions, contact Hilltopper Refuse at 608-783-6727.



ATV's – UTV's – GOLF CARTS



Village Ordinance #105 regulates the operation of ATV's, UTV's and Golf Carts in the Village of Ettrick. Operators of ATV's, UTV's and Golf Carts must be at least 16 years old. Penalty for unauthorized use will be \$50.00 per occurrence plus all fees, costs and penalties including Attorney's fees. **Motorized Vehicles are prohibited on Village Walking Trails.** If you have any questions please contact the Village Office at 608-525-5445



FALL CLEAN UP



Residents are asked to edge your sidewalks, clean weeds from curbs and gutters and sweep the street in front of your property. The Village Maintenance Department will pick up yard waste and small branches periodically during the fall clean up season. Lawn waste/leaves must be bagged and branches tied in 4 foot bundles and placed at the curb **not in the street**. The village will not pick up large amounts of brush or trees-only branches. They will not pick up yard waste that is not properly prepared. **Yard waste disposal is available at the Village yard waste site. This site is for YARD WASTE ONLY. People continue to dispose of demolition materials, household items and garbage at the site. The village has incurred significant expense for proper disposal of items that are inappropriately left at the site. If residents continue to abuse access to this service the yard waste site will be closed.**

SNOW AND ICE REMOVAL - ALTERNATE SIDE PARKING

Village Ordinance #3A controls the removal of ice & snow from Village sidewalks. It is the responsibility of all property owners or occupants of residential areas or vacant lots adjacent to sidewalks and all owners or occupants of any commercial building or business to remove all snow & ice from the sidewalks in front of their property within (24) hours after the cessation of winter storms.

Village Ordinance #101B controls winter parking regulations. Alternate side parking begins on November 1st and continues through April 15th. Any vehicle parked under the provisions of this ordinance shall be parked only on even-numbered sides of the street on an even calendar date, and on odd-numbered sides of the street on an odd calendar date. **An "even calendar date" is defined as a day on which the portion starting at noon is on an even day and continues until noon**

the following day, and an “odd calendar date” is a day on which the portion starting at noon is an odd day and continues until noon of the following day.

No parking from 2:30 a.m. to 6:00 a.m. on Main Street from Second Street to State Street, and on First Street West from Main Street to Market Street.

This ordinance does not apply to emergency vehicles.
